HAZARDOUS MATERIALS HANDLING CHARGE

A charge of \$35.00 will be assessed on any shipment containing hazardous materials as defined by the U.S. Department of Transportation Regulations, including Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations Parts 100 through 180 (applies only to commodities which are assigned an NA or UN number). The Hazardous Material Handling Charge will be in addition to all other applicable charges.

Hazardous material shipments must be tendered on the carrier's bill of lading. Shipper shall comply with all applicable D.O.T. regulations regarding the transportation of hazardous materials, including identifying the shipment as being hazardous, providing the appropriate description sequence of the hazardous material, providing emergency contact information, and proper packaging and labeling of the hazardous material.

Please see Item 780 for a complete list of prohibited or restricted articles.

Mexico Hazardous Materials Handling Charge

When shipments are tendered for delivery or pickup in Mexico & meet the above criteria for a hazardous shipment a \$100.00 charge will be applied. This is in addition to all other applicable charges including the \$35.00 charge mentioned in paragraph 1. This fee will be assessed against the payor of the freight charges.
