

PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED ARTICLES

The articles listed below will not be accepted for shipment or as premiums accompanying other articles. The carrier will not be liable for delay, loss or damage to a shipment of any prohibited articles. In the event prohibited or restricted articles are accepted for transport by the carrier, the shipper shall indemnify and hold the carrier harmless from any claim or cause arising from the tender of any prohibited or restricted articles for shipment or violation of any municipal, state or federal law or regulation.

Alcoholic liquors or beverages moving intrastate, or originating from or destined to KY.

Articles which because of their bulk, length, width, or height cannot be safely stowed within a trailer or container.

Articles requiring protection from heat or cold.

Articles liable to impregnate or otherwise damage equipment or other freight.

Articles of extraordinary value.

Automobiles.

Bank Bills.

Bullion.

Cannabis, CBD, Hemp, Marijuana and products containing these ingredients with a THC content of greater than 0.3% by dry weight (See NOTE 6).

Carbon Black, Graphite Powder contained in insufficient packaging.

Cigarettes, cigars, smokeless tobacco, electronic nicotine delivery, or any commodity containing tobacco or imitation tobacco or those mixed with these ingredients when delivering to the end consumer.

Clams, crabs, lobsters, oysters, and shrimp.

Currency, other than coin. (See NOTE 1).

Deeds.

Drafts.

Engines Containing Liquid (See NOTE 7).

Firearms, other than "antique firearms" or disassembled firearm parts (See NOTE 5)

Fish, except smoked or canned.

Flora and fauna (live plants).

Furs.

Hazardous Material viz:

- Aluminum Phosphide, Chemical Hazard Risk Assessment 18 or greater
- Dangerous when wet (Class 4.3)
- Infectious substances (Class 6.2)
- Explosives (Class 1.1, 1.2, and 1.3)

Hides, green or wet.

Jewelry, other than costume or novelty jewelry (See NOTE 2).

Letters, with or without stamps affixed.

Mail when the consignor and consignee are U.S. Post Offices.

Money or notes.

Mounted or stuffed animals to or from Canada.

Museum exhibits or articles of antiquity (See NOTE 3).

Original works of art, statues or paintings (See NOTE 4).

Pesticides recalled by the manufacturer or pesticides that have been suspended and canceled (refer to 40 CFR 273.3). Pianos.

Platinum, gold, silver, and other precious metals.

Polychlorinated biphenyls, liquid UN2315, solid UN3432

Precious stones, cut or uncut.

Quicksilver (Metallic Mercury).

Radioactive Waste.

Revenue stamps.

Securities, stamps, stock certificates, or letters.

Shipments that contain in whole or in part, articles prohibited by law.

Spent Lead Batteries, i.e. batteries that contain or contained acid.

Used fluorescent bulbs moving to a recycler.

Used or obsolete mercury containing equipment.

Valuable papers including documents containing

Personal Identifiable Information (PII).

Watches.

When shipments are tendered for delivery or pickup in Mexico, the following articles shall not be accepted as shipments or premiums accompanying other articles. These articles shall be in addition to any previously mentioned article or rule mentioned under Item 780.

PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED ARTICLES

NOTE 1: Monetary coins will not be accepted as premiums with other articles except as authorized in NMFC Item 310.

NOTE 2: Costume jewelry, actual value not exceeding values stipulated in Item 848 will be accepted for transportation.

NOTE 3: Except antique furniture subject to NMFC Item 100240 or numismatic exhibits subject to NMFC Item 63830.

NOTE 4: Except pictures or paintings subject to NMFC Items 56165 and 100240.

NOTE 5: Acceptable for transportation are “antique firearms” including muzzle loading rifles, muzzle loading shotguns, and muzzle loading pistols that are designed to use black powder or a black powder substitute and cannot use fixed ammunition.

NOTE 6: Shipments with a THC content of 0.3% or less that would otherwise be eligible for transport are prohibited if they emit a distinct odor commonly associated with marijuana. Additionally, shipments that are marketed, labeled, or presented in a manner that could reasonably be construed as marijuana or a marijuana derivative are not eligible for transport regardless of THC content. If requested, Shippers must provide documentation certifying the THC content of the product in accordance with applicable federal and state laws. If shipments containing Cannabis, CBD, Hemp, Marijuana, or any products incorporating these substances with a THC content of greater than 0.3% by dry weight are inadvertently accepted, the following rating guidelines will apply: the shipment will be rated at NMFC Class 300, with no application of any Freight All Kinds (FAK) provisions. If the shipment is subject to density or dimension-based pricing, a default density of 1.5 pounds per cubic foot (PCF) will be used. Applicable discounts will not be honored.

NOTE 7: A fuel tank containing a flammable liquid fuel must be drained and securely closed, except that up to 500 ml (17 ounces) of residual fuel may remain in the tank, engine components, or fuel lines provided they are securely closed to prevent leakage of fuel during transportation.
