- 2 Door-to-door with Broker Provided by Consignee** shipments originate in the United States and deliver directly to your Mexican destination with the border crossing service provided by the consignee's selected customs broker. Simply advise us of the broker contact information on the freight bill and SEFL will work with your broker at the border. SEFL will make final delivery into Mexico.

Mexico's law requires that the Mexican entity (the consignee) be the importer of record and that they be registered with a Mexican broker. When freight arrives at the border the consignee's customs broker will have to clear customs and deliver freight to SEFL's Mexican partner carrier in Nuevo Laredo, MX. The Mexican partner carrier will then deliver freight to final consignee.
